Student Agreement

Education is important to me. I am the one responsible for my own success. As a student I will be responsible for the following:

Parent/Guardian Agreement

I understand that participation in my student's education is vital to his or her success. As a parent or guardian, I will be responsible for the following:

- Ensuring my student comes to school each day, on time, prepared to learn.
- Providing basic needs such as adequate sleep, nourishment, supervision, and hygiene.
- Providing an appropriate time and place to study and encouraging my student to complete all homework according to his/her class's homework policy. I will view the planner and/or leadership notebook provided by the school, and sign as needed.
- Ensuring my student is reading or being read to at least 20 minutes per day, every day.

- Assisting the school in maintaining discipline and dress code policies.
- Encouraging positive out of school time by monitoring the amount and content of television viewing, video gaming, and internet use.
